**Subject :** From the Academic Year 2021-22, by taking the review, decrease the intake capacity of the courses which are not in demand in Government Polytechnics, to start new courses in accordance with the demand etc.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, the Government permits the closure of the courses in the government polytechnics for which the admissions were not satisfactory in the last five years. The Government also permits to decrease the intake capacity, to start the new courses according to the scope and demand, to take the review of the courses which were started only for girls and convert them for co-education. The permissions are granted in accordance with the demands and they are mentioned in the enclosed Annexures.

- To decrease the intake capacity in the first and second shift of the Government Polytechnics is mentioned in the Annexure A & B
- To start new courses in the Government Polytechnics is mentioned in the Annexure C.

- Closure of the courses which are not in demand in the Government Polytechnics is mentioned in the Annexure D.
- To decrease the intake capacity as well as convert the status of the courses which were only meant "For Girls" to both boys and girls i.e. "Co-Education" are mentioned in Annexure E.

The above permissions are granted subject to the following terms and conditions.

- A. The Government will not give any independent grant except regular budgetary allocations for the basic infrastructure like class rooms and other facilities for the new courses.
- B. The Government will not create new posts for these new courses or the Government will not sanction or accept any proposal of creating new posts for these courses.
- C. The whole and sole responsibility of fulfillment of the teaching posts by the conversion of posts or transfer of posts, will lie on the Director, Directorate of Technical Education.
